

At the 2014 Dominion Convention held in Edmonton, a revision was made to the definition of a Veteran. A **Veteran** is any person who is serving or has honourably served in the Canadian Armed Forces, the Commonwealth or its wartime allies, or as a Regular Member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, or as a Peace Officer in a Special Duty Area or on a Special Duty Operation, or who has served in the Merchant Navy, or Ferry Command during wartime.
